



Rules

COUPE PEPE 2010
September 3-4-5
Saint-Hyacinthe

1. The Coupe PEPE will take place in Saint-Hyacinthe on September 3-4-5 on the fields PHD-1, PHD-2 and PHD3, as well as on the nearby fields Bois-joly-1 and Bois-Joly-2.
2. The purpose of this event is to raise funds to allow needy children to fulfill their dream of playing soccer.
3. This friendly sport tournament is organized by the players of the PEPE Football Club and their spouses and by a group of partners who have this cause at heart.
4. The teams and players who register at the Coupe PEPE must do so in promising to play with sportsmanship, without excessive brutality and by respecting their opponent.
5. No physical contact will be tolerated. After a team accumulates 5 fouls of this nature in a game, a penalty shot will be awarded to the opponent team for each additional fault of the same nature.
6. A team can register in the category of its choice.
7. Each player pays 20 \$ for the tournament.
8. Each team plays a minimum of 3 games and a maximum of 5 (based on the number of registrations)
9. In categories where at least 6 teams are registered, 2 pools of 3 teams will be organized and the final will take place between the 2 first-place finishers.
10. The organizing committee cannot be held liable for any accident or injury (refer to your personal insurance).
11. The rules of the game are those of FIFA, with the following specifications:
 - a. Substitutions are allowed at all time after approval of the referee
 - b. All games will last 50 minutes (2 x 25 minutes)
 - c. Each team will play a minimum of 3 games and a maximum of 5 gamesScoring: Victory = 3 points
 Draw = 1 point
 Team with the highest mean age: 1 point per game (win or lose)
 Lost = 0 point
12. In case of equality in the standings, the team that will qualify is the one that:
 - a. has the most point
 - b. the winner of the game played between them
 - c. has the most goals for
 - d. will have the less red cards
 - e. will have the less yellow cards
